The 43rd annual SHS Harvest Festival is open to the public. Art, handmade crafts, and food will be for sale throughout both days of the event. Free tours of three historic homes and a one-room schoolhouse are offered. Children's activities include hands-on interactive animal display and pumpkin decorating. Children and adults alike will enjoy meeting the blacksmith, watching the woodcarvers, and stirring apple butter over an open fire. Musical entertainment will be both days.

Stow Ohio is located northeast of Akron Ohio. The Harvest Festival is held at Stow's Silver Springs Park on Young Road (east side of the park). Follow Graham Rd east to Newcomer Rd. Go north on Newcomer Rd to Young Rd. Continue north on Young Rd to 5120 Young Rd, Stow, Ohio.

Members of Stow Historical Society will be selling jars of apple butter and refreshments in the Heritage Barn.
