About the Festival

The Harvest Festival, started in 1978, brings artisans, crafters, musicians, families, and the community together. Festival attendees get the opportunity to experience everyday life as it happened when Stow was first settled. Three of the four historic buildings at the Heritage Reserve park will be open for tours. There will be a family area with games, activities, and animals to pet. Arts and crafts vendors will have booths throughout the park and traditional music will be performed. Hundreds of visitors come through the festival each day.

Your Help is Needed!

The Harvest Festival is our main fundraising event every year. SHS uses the funds we earn from the festival to preserve, repair, and share the historic buildings in the Heritage Reserve park which is under the direction of The Stow Historical Society. The Minnie Darrow House, Mary Starr House, and Stewart School Museums are restored and ready for visitors. This year, the Festival will be our primary fundraiser to help restore the Heritage House Museum from a fire late in 2023. SHS volunteers work year-round getting the buildings ready for the festival. However, we do need funding to keep the properties going. We are asking for sponsors for each of the buildings in addition to general festival sponsorship. We also accept gifts in kind for our basket raffle. We are a 501c3 and we can attach or send our W9 form if needed, as well.
